MMKSS (Mitwa Mahila Kalyan Evam Sewa Samiti) was established in 2004 under the Societies Registration Act 1973 with reg. Number 2066. The vision of our organization is a society where people live with dignity and equality, free from hunger, free from exploitation by feudalism, patriarchy and bureaucracy. To support the community for their self-reliance. The mission of the organization is to empower family living in the community through intensive capacity building and interventions with special focus on children and women and believes in empowering the socioeconomically disadvantaged sections.

The organization is supporting the education of adolescent boys and girls through its motivational support in Anganwadis and schools. The organization is currently working on education, Nutrition, health and safety of children and women in 20 villages of Mahasamund district and 8 slum areas of Bilaspur district and 3 villages of Korba district with total beneficiary families 3870 children 7269.

1. Education for all

Activity Center Children & Adolescents:-

In 20 villages of Pithora block of Mahasamund district of Chhattisgarh state, 5 activity centers have been set up at Gopalpur, Pilwapali, Amlidih, Chhobra, Ghocha. A total of 500 children are taking free digital education at the centre. Due to poor socio-economic condition and weak financial condition the parents of our target area are unable to send their children for proper education. Besides this, unavailability of educational facility in remote ignorance of the community is also responsible for the low enrollment and retention status. School conditions lead to high dropout rates in areas where MMKSS intervenes. The drop out of boys and girls is high in these areas.



Therefore, an initiative was taken to bring these children into the mainstream in the form of remedial education centers. At the same time, 2 Activity centers have been opened in 2 slum areas of Bilaspur district, in which children are being given free digital education and computer education. A total of 2 Activity centers are running in Imlibhata, Atal Awas Sakri, due to which education 300 children are getting benefitted. The teachers in these informal centers are from the local community and they teach in the local dialect, especially in slum and downtrodden areas. Books, TLM, sports material are being made available to attract children towards education. The aim of running the activity centre is to ensure that children do not

drop out of school and all children get proper education, that too through digital medium, so that children can study well and become self-reliant.

Education Awareness Campaign:-

On 15th to 30th June 2024, the Mitwa Mahila Kalyan Eevam Seva Samiti organized the School Chalo Abhiyan program in 20 villages of Mahasamund district and 10 slum areas of Bilaspur district, 10 villages of Korba district. The main objective of this program is to make the people of the community aware of education. And motivate the children of the community to enroll in the school. Thus 300 parents and 700 children participated in this programme. The organization holds meetings with the members of the community every month, information about the education of the children is taken from the parents and the parents are asked to send the children to school every day and the children are taken care of by the Parents Parents are told about the importance of education..



National Education Policy :-

District level workshop on National Education Policy was organized in which community members and school teachers were informed about early childhood of the child, child care and guidance towards education, curriculum and pedagogy in schools: learning should be holistic, integrated, joyful and engaging, quality education and free and compulsory education as per RTE norms, providing vocational education, digital education in schools. Information was given about etc. Community members and teachers were informed about the children studying in the area and those who have dropped out of school through PPT and were asked to encourage children to study so that they can become self-reliant in the future.



Awareness Campaigns on Child Education & Protection with different stakeholders :-

Block level workshop was organized to create awareness about the education and safety of children in which it was discussed with the CBO members and government official that even today children do not go to school and do not study in Pithora block. The official was told that the curriculum and pedagogy in schools should be holistic, integrated, enjoyable and



attractive, information was given about quality education and free and compulsory education as per the norms of RTE, vocational education in schools, providing digital education etc. and the CBO members were asked to tell the children of the village about the importance of education so that the children study. And the ill effects of child marriage and child labor were discussed. It was also told that the families living in the village migrate to other states on which the government is not doing anything.



Capacity Building Of AWW, Teachers And Community Leaders On Age And Subject Specific Learning Program:-

Capacity building program for Anganwadi workers, teachers and community leaders was organized for age and subject specific education in which capacity building of Anganwadi workers, teachers and community leaders was done and the following topics were discussed that for good education of children, attention should also be paid to the environment of one's home and they were asked to keep on

motivating them continuously for education. , The role of education at different ages of children was explained that , Elementary education (0-6 years), primary education (6 -12 years), secondary education (12 -18 years) and higher education (18+ years) were explained in detail. ,It was told that right subject at the right age is the basis of education.,The continuous importance of education from



childhood to adulthood was explained., Its contribution in the development of personality and society was explained, how a child learns and he also told that before teaching the children, one should teach the children himself so that it becomes easier to explain to the child and the child can understand easily etc. Information was given on such topics so that the children can study well.

School Department Plan And SMC Meeting:-

MMKSS organized a workshop on the school department plan in which the school teachers and SMC members were informed about the school development plan and were given a SDP form which they were asked to fill and submit to the District Education Officer's office. The organization conducts monthly meetings of the SMC members in which the SMC members were told that all members should be present regularly in the meetings and the SMC was told about its functions and its roles and responsibilities. The SMC members were told to regularly take information about the quality of mid-day meals, drinking water and sanitation facilities in the school and were asked to monitor the school teachers.



Life Skill Session:-

The organization organizes training workshops for the children living in the area to enhance their skills and understanding, in which children are made to do various activities such as who am I, handprint, my uniqueness, self-confidence, self-power, positive outlook, magic box, developing one's own worth, self-esteem of children, solving problems despite circumstances, sensitizing self-respect, etc. Children are given three-day



training on these topics in groups of 20 each. The training is given in three parts, which are given to children in the age group of 10 to 18 years, so that the children can solve any kind of problem that comes their way and come out of it, by saying this the training is given to the children. So far around 2700 children have been trained and the skills of those children have been developed.

Dry Ration Distribution:-

Apart from the tribal community residing in Korba district, the people of reserved castes are able to eat only in the morning and afternoon and remain without food at night and due to the presence of a lot of forest in the village, they are not able to do farming, due to which most of the children residing in the village become victims of malnutrition. Keeping this in mind, the organization distributed dry ration to the members of the tribal community, so that all the members can eat three to four times a day and do not fall prey to malnutrition, saying this, the dry ration distribution program has been started.



Fee payment support:-

To attract children from slums and tribal areas towards education and to create interest in education, we got 85 drop out children of 10th and 12th class admitted to open school and 85 children to college. The organization paid the fees of 60 children. Its objective is that even poor children living in villages and slum areas can study and become something in the future.

Education Mapping:-

Education mapping has been initiated by MMKSS in the target villages to ascertain the status of education process in the region. This mapping shows school status, teachers, enrollment and retention, MDM, no. Enrolment, sanitation and available drinking water facilities etc. This year we do education mapping in 47 schools in tribal areas. A report was also prepared and accordingly the monitoring process was initiated.



Assessment and Examination of students:-

Every new student is assessed at the time of joining the learning centre. Students are assessed through pre-tests and post-tests. Children undergo standardized tests to assess their reading, comprehension and mathematical ability. Around 500 children were tested.



Career Counseling Training:-

The organization told the children of the area who passed class 10th what they become by taking commerce subject, what they become by taking arts subject, what they become by taking maths subject, what they become by taking biology subject and the children who passed class 12th were told what ITI and college are, what will be the importance of doing ITI and information was given about the importance of college.



Detailed information was given on what children will become by taking which subject, which benefited 650 children.



2. Health:-

Pre-Education And Milk distribution Program :-

Child malnutrition is a major public health problem that has adverse short-term and long-term health effects. Looking at the current scenario in Korba, Mitwa Sanstha is working towards “Pre-school Nutrition and Education” to the rural and tribal deprived children of the society, under which 1 glass of milk and 4 pieces of biscuits are being provided daily for 6 days a week to children aged 6 months to 5 years, so that tribal deprived children can be free from malnutrition.



3. People's organizations

Formation of CBOs and SHGs :-

CBO formation and pressure building is our main tool to proceed the advocacy process. 640 member are formed in our target area to build up pressure on administration in related to different issues of area lie educational gaps, health irregularities, unreach of welfare schemes etc. the CBOs are having to initiate the. Till CBOs had initiated issues like irregular vaccination of children ad hoping mothers, lack of infrastructure in PHC and CHC, lack of staff at night in health centers, school irregularities etc and get success to



regularize all these services in their area and PHCs availed infrastructures for institutional deliveries.

Our working area formed 40 SHGs/CBO Group and 1835 members. They are actively involved for self and community developments. Every week taking meeting of CBO during this meeting discussed various issue as women health, children health & education and community problems. For solving problem making application for collector, Education Department, community representatives.

Bal Club Meeting and Workshop:-

Formation of Bal Club and pressure building is our main tool to take forward the advocacy process. 56 Bal Clubs with 1120 members have been formed in our target area so that pressure can be created on the administration regarding various issues of the area such as education. Bal Club is giving a better

opportunity to children to develop and make them aware of their child rights and health, education issues. Discussions were made in the Bal Club meeting. Information about health, education and child rights was given through painting, song, poem, drama, dance, rangoli and other activities. In this way, workshop programs are organized about information meetings to find out the status and progress of education and health of the Bal-Club members in which Bal Club children are present and they make the children aware of their rights through many activities like painting, speech, rangoli and poster presentation so that the children remain aware of their rights.



Adolescent Group Meetings and Workshops -

Adolescent groups were formed in selected slums and tribal communities. Our main tool is to build pressure before the advocacy process. At present, there are 840 members in 42 adolescent groups. The worker organizes adolescent group meetings every month, in which the changes that occur with increasing age, physical, mental-social development, are discussed so that they do not get scared when the changes occur and adolescents are made aware of legal rights and health issues. At the same time, subjects of studies are also discussed and information is taken from the adolescents from time to time about whether they have any kind of problem. Adolescent children are advised to do vocational training in embroidery-sewing, nursing, computer, mobile repairing etc. and children are also admitted to vocational training centers so that they can work somewhere.



Cyber Security / National period awareness –

National period and a workshop on cyber security were organized for teenagers from selected tribal communities and slums. In which teenagers were told that how they become victims of fraud and how people steal your media profile, on this you can file an FIR with the police and teenagers were told that you should not take the photo or ID of any unknown person, and



Teenagers are given information about periods, in which girls are told why periods

come, how to use cloth or sanitary pads in periods and for how long and girls are told not to be shy about taking pads in medical and given detailed information about period.

Sports Programme :-

The Mitwa Mahila Kalyan Evam Seva Samiti brought tribal children from the Pithora block of Mahasamund, who had never played outside the village, but only played at the Mitwa-run activity center, to the Pithora block grounds and organized a sports program, which attracted 115 participants. Similarly, a sports program was organized for children living in slum areas of Bilaspur district, with 130 participants.

Various sports, including cricket, kabaddi, badminton, and running, were played on the occasion. The children play with children from outside their community. To promote children's development, the organization organizes monthly sports activities at the activity center, enabling them to participate in district and state-level sports competitions.



Capacity building

SMCs Member Monitoring:-

After formation and proper facilitation of SMCs they were imparted trainings on their roles and responsibilities. Because the SMCs are having an important role to bring quality in education and MDM. This training is completed in 15 slum and 30 villages including.

Staff Review Meetings:-

Staff review meeting also helps the staff to develop their capacity as they can monitor their work and plan accordingly. Regular monthly, quarterly and annual review meetings were arranged where the staff could analyze their activities and prepare plans for the next implementation. Budget analysis is done in these meetings. This year MMKSS organized training programs to prepare work plan, submit monthly report, make work strategy and develop capacity of staff on any issue. This year staff capacity building meetings were organized on a wide range of issues like education, safety, health, RTE Act, gender violence etc.



Day Celebration:-

Independence Day:-

On 15-08-2024, a program was organized by Mitwa Mahila Kalyan Eevam Seva Samiti on the occasion of Independence Day in which competitions like dance, rangoli, speech etc. were organized in which 150 parents and children participated. In this program, various activities were done by the children in the form of songs, poems, speeches, simple and cultural activities and the children were given detailed information about Independence Day and the children celebrated Independence Day well, along with this, the children were also rewarded to increase their enthusiasm so that the children participate in the competition.



Republished day:-

On 26-01-2025, Mitwa Mahila Kalyan Evam Seva Samiti organized a program on the occasion of Republic Day, in which awareness rallies were taken out by the children to make the children and parents of the community aware about education.



Many types of slogans were spoken in the rally to make them aware about education and competitions like dance, rangoli, speech etc. were organized in the school, in which 200 parents and children participated. In this program, various activities were done by the children in the form of songs, poems, speeches, simple and cultural activities and the children were given detailed information about Republic Day.

Teachers' Day: 05 September 2024 :-

On 05.09.2024, Mitwa Mahila Kalyan Evam Seva Samiti organized a Teachers' Day program on the occasion of Teachers' Day, in which teachers were honored by the children and the children were told that we cannot live without a Guru in life and the importance of Guru in life was told.



Fund flow Conclusion:-

2024-25 was an important and successful year for MMKSS. The programs were implemented well and the learning levels of the children reached a status which is clearly visible. In order to be ready for the next era, MMKSS has identified its need to focus more and more on learning quality improvement for children and to take them to the depth of learning and more inclusion of excluded groups. Along with MMKSS also planning to provide the sustainable livelihood to the community which will help the parents to be stable and think about the rights of their child. MMKSS will strengthen its structure and planning to extend its work to more areas and planned to achieve more beneficiaries. MMKSS aims at moving towards setting up and integrating the existing direct programs under one umbrella by ensuring sustainability. Through the selective support mechanism in 2015-16, MMKSS will remain as firmly committed to this vision as always.
